# Cultural Organizations' Funding

## **Self-generated revenues**

- tickets or admissions, concessions, facility rentals, memberships, sales or rentals of works, gift shops, and other operations

## **Government**

- at all levels

## **Private Sector**

- individuals, corporations and foundations

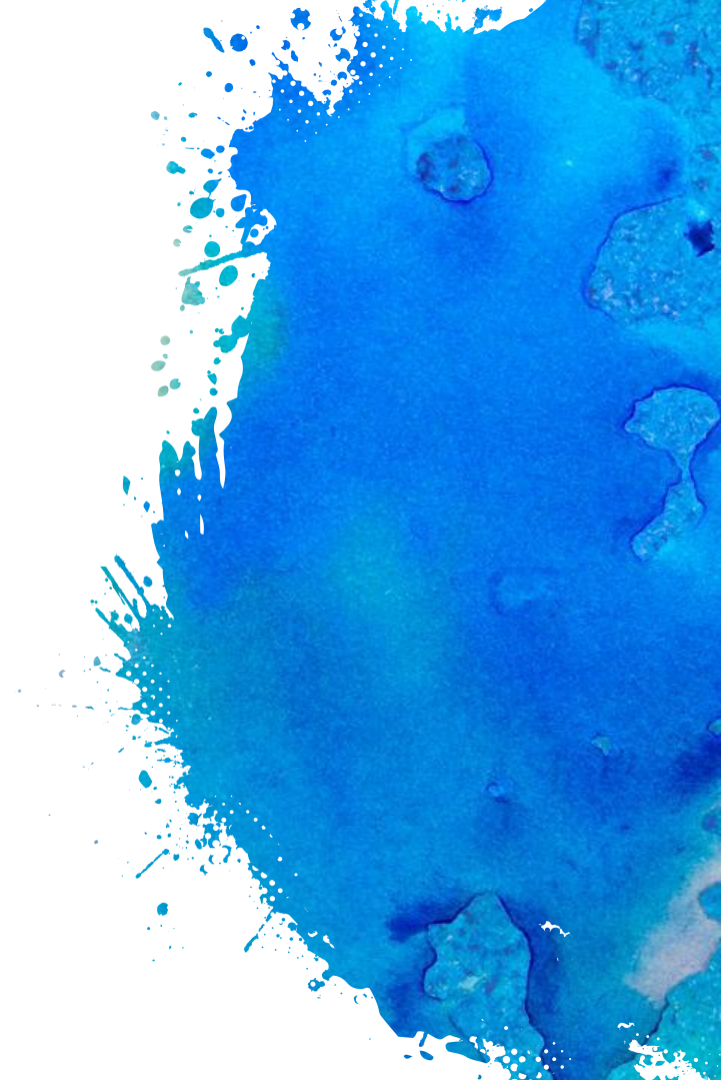

- Grants are available in four streams
- You can make application for more than one funding stream at a time
- Organizations must register with OTF before making application

# OTF – Investment Strategy

## **SEED Grants**

*Funding for projects at the idea or conceptual stage*

\$5,000 - \$75,000 available, term up to one year

Deadline for submission: February 21, 2018

## **GROW Grants**

*Funding to build on the success of a proven model or program*

\$50,000 - \$250,000 per year, 2 -3 year term

Deadline for submission: May 16, 2018



# OTF – Investment Strategy

## **CAPITAL Grants**

*Funding to broaden access to and improve community spaces*

\$5,000 - \$150,000 available, term up to one year

Deadline for submission: August 15, 2018

## **TRANSFORM Grants**

*Funding to tackle complex community issues and creating lasting change*

Funding amount and term to be determined

Deadline for submission: November 7, 2018





# OTF Investment Strategy

Grant applications can be made in the following **Action Areas**

## **Active People** - *Fostering more active lifestyles*

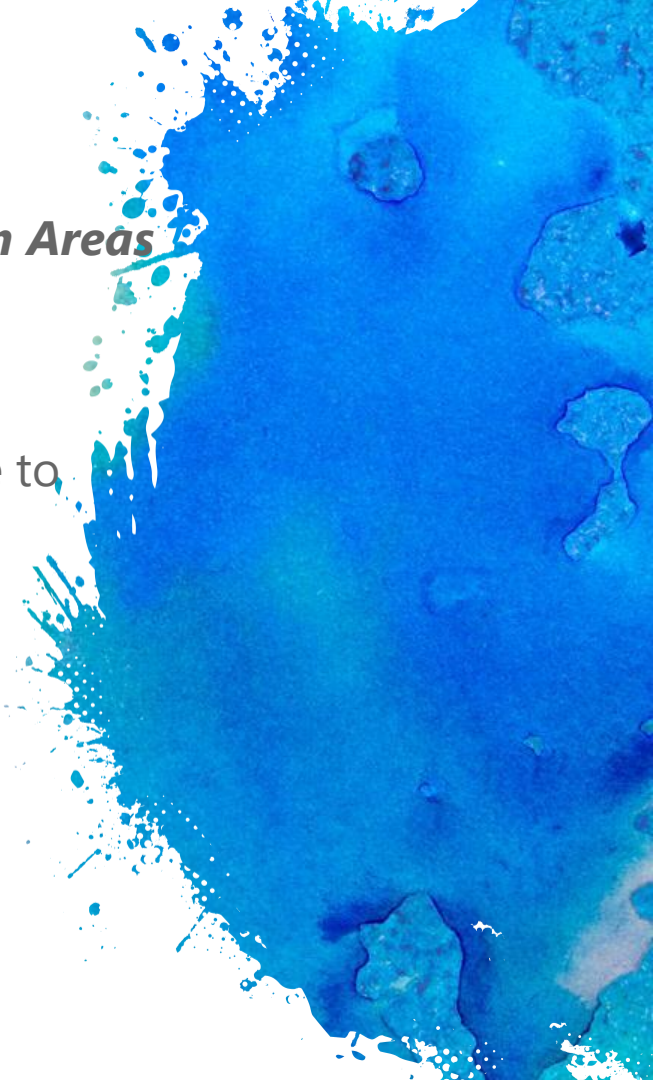
### Priority Outcomes

Higher quality programming and infrastructure to support physical activity  
More people become active

## **Connected People** – *Building inclusive and engaged communities together*

### Priority Outcomes

Diverse groups work better together to shape community  
Reduced social isolation



# OTF Investment Strategy

**Green People** – *Encouraging people to support a healthy and sustainable environment*

Priority Outcomes

More ecosystems are protected and restored

People reduce their impact on the environment

**Inspired People** – *enriching people's live through arts, culture and heritage*

Priority Outcomes

Better quality programming and infrastructure to experience culture, heritage and the arts

More people connect with culture, heritage and the arts





# OTF – Capital Grant – Inspired People

## First Step

Register your organization by July 25, 2018.

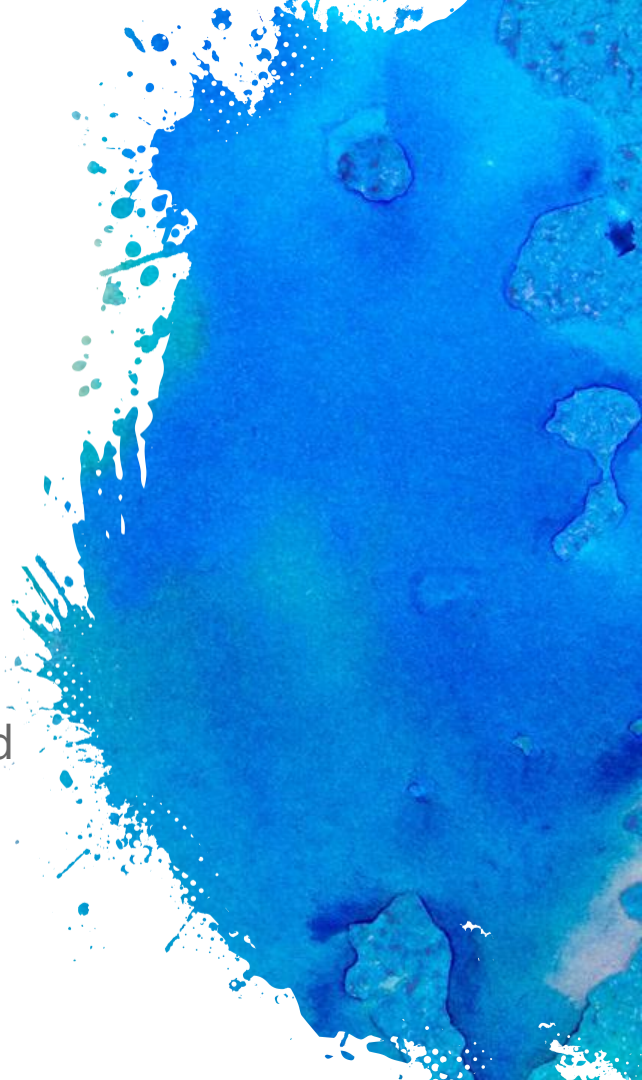
## Next Step

Determine if there is a OTF workshop in the region you might attend to better understand the Capital Grant investment stream.

## Next Step

Set-up a telephone meeting with an OTF Program Manager to determine if the project you have identified is eligible for funding.

Listen carefully to the language the Program Manager uses when discussing your project and be sure to use the same language in your application.



# OTF – Capital Grant – Inspired People

## **Next Step**

Review the application well before the deadline to determine the information you will require.

- Need project will address
- Project outcomes
- Letters of support
- Budget

## **Next Step**

Complete the application form.

## **Final Step**

Submit the application form.



# OTF Investment Strategy

**Promising Young People** – *Supporting the positive development of children and youth*

Priority Outcomes

Parents, caregivers and adult allies have the skills to support children and youth who are facing barriers  
Youth facing barriers volunteer and are in leadership roles

**Prosperous People** – *Enhancing people's economic wellbeing*

Priority Outcomes

Increased economic stability  
Increased economic opportunity

## **Municipal Government**

Community Partnership and Development Fund Grant

50/50 Community Project Capital Fund

Organizations making application for funds for capital projects can request up to \$7,500.

Applications must be received prior to October 31<sup>st</sup>.



# Other Sources of Funding

## Canada Council for Arts

Funding for both artists and cultural organizations in the form of grants, endowments or awards to help with various project costs, including production, travel and residency costs.

**NOTE:** Many grants, like those offered through the Canada Council for Arts, have a multi-step process to making application for funding.

### **Deadlines for applications:**

Some of the deadlines for applications are fixed and some are "any time before the start of a project" up to a stated date.

## Deadlines for applications:

There is a rolling system of deadlines for grant opportunities as such it is important to identify the deadline that applies to the specific grant you are making application to.

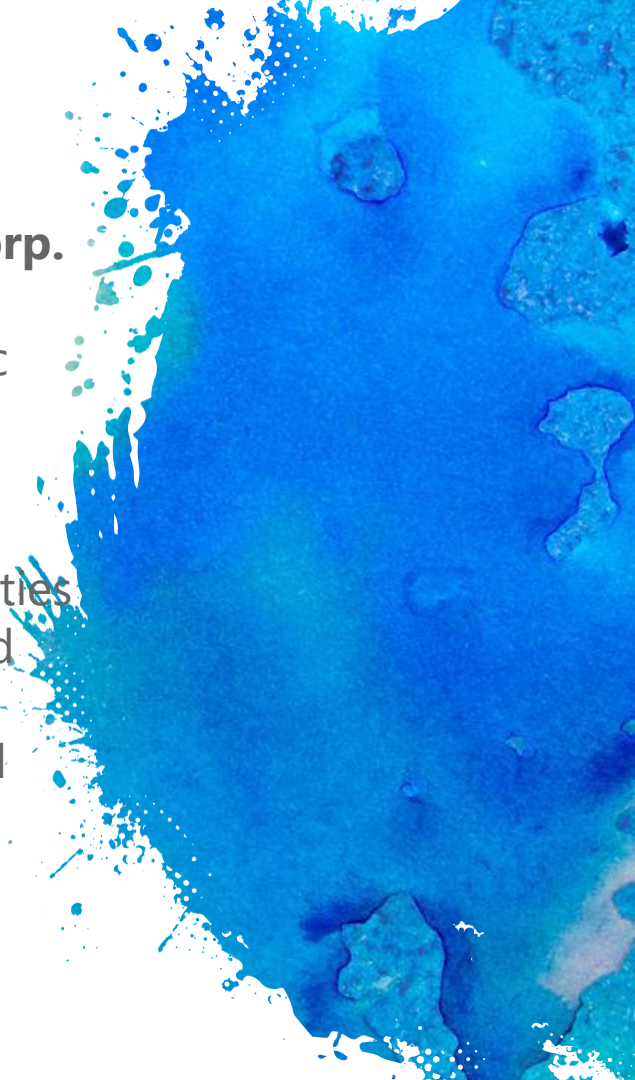
