Work will be juried for entry. Registration money will be refunded to non-successful applicants.

MADE IN KAWARTHA LAKES RULES AND REGULATIONS... please read carefully!

- 1. You may only show media for which you have been juried, so ensure your photos cover the variety of media and style of all the work you would like to exhibit. You are welcome to submit more than 3 images if desired.
- 2. **All pieces on display or for sale must be ORIGINAL** works created by the artist/artisan. Prints/reproductions MUST be labelled as such and may only constitute 20% of the works actually displayed. They may be sold in your booth in a bin. The KLAC Board has the option of requesting removal of work that does not comply with the exhibition conditions.
- 3. All artists/artisans are responsible for their own booth insurance. KLAC carries general liability insurance only for the event..
- 4. Exhibitors will provide any backdrops/easels/shelving/additional tables for displaying work aside from the one provided by KLAC. Backdrops may not be more than 8' high. All exhibitors are responsible for handling/installing their own artwork and display materials. Please bring your own booth chairs. Outdoor artists are responsible for bringing and installing/taking down their own canopies. Please bring a helper if you require assistance putting up your booth.
- 5. SET UP time will be available Friday afternoon (exact time to be confirmed), and at 8 a.m. Saturday morning. Do NOT arrive earlier than this on Saturday. Your booth **must** remain intact for the open hours of the show. There will be security guards onsite for Friday and Saturday nights after the show is closed, but exhibitors should be careful about leaving small valuable works in outside booths. Buildings will be locked.
- 6. Refunds for cancellations will not be given after May 15th.
- 7. Admission to the event for the general public is a donation.
- 8. All exhibitors should advertise the show via social media and their personal email list for best attendance. KLAC will provide you with a digital copy of the show poster once your application has been approved.
- 9. There are a number of options for accommodation in the Bobcaygeon area. Please check out the local Chamber of Commerce website.
- 10. Kawartha Lakes Arts Council's yearly membership is \$40 for an artist, \$60 for a NFP arts organization, and \$80 for a business membership.
- 11. Members who provide their e-mail addresses will receive emails from KLAC, but members' email addresses will not be sold or shared. Members agree that any photos, videos or other image or sound recording media provided by the member to KLAC will be used to promote the member or their membership in KLAC.
